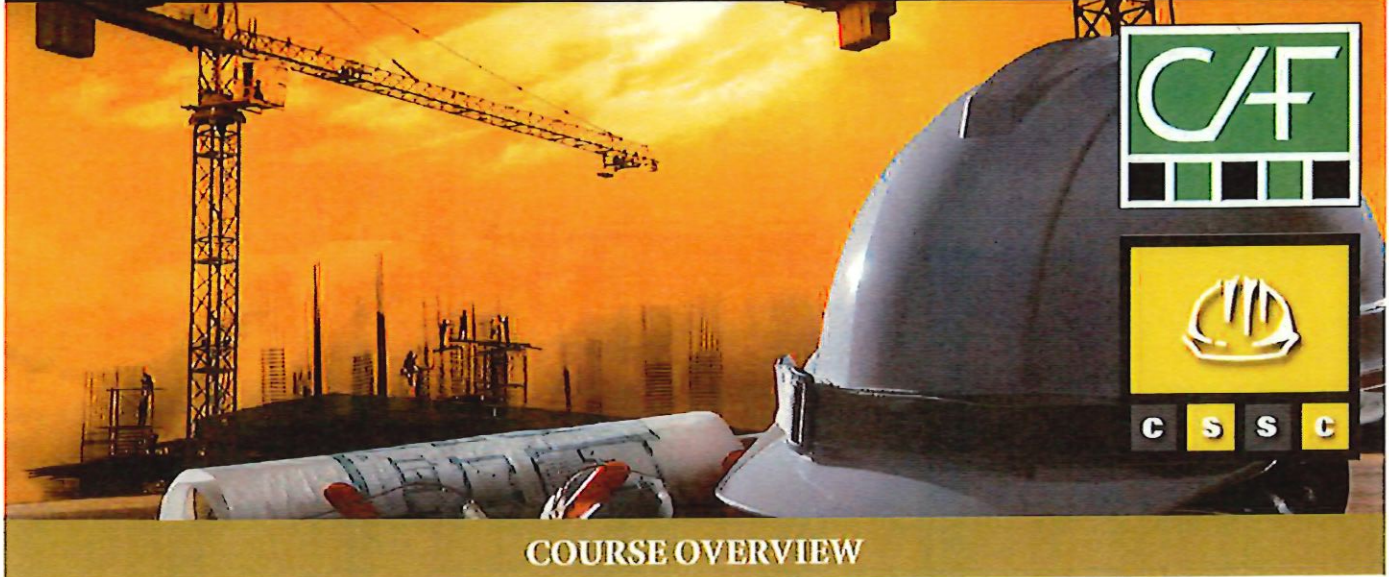


Process Safety Management
